**Art League of Hilton Head on** Hilton Head Island, SC, Features Works by Bill Bogle, Jr.

The Art League of Hilton Head on Hilton Head Island, SC, will present Eloquent *Light*, featuring landscape photography by Bill Bogle, Jr., on view in the Art League Gallery, located inside the Arts Center of Coastal Carolina, from Oct. 1 - 26, 2019. A reception will be held on Oct. 9, from 5-7pm. The artist is hosting two gallery walks on Oct. 5 and 19 to discuss his work in greater detail.

The exhibit includes familiar Lowcountry scenes of Spanish moss-draped live oaks and oceanfront dunes, the vibrant red rock formations of the American west, and solemn views along the

New England coast. Bogle's passion and success lie in recording moments when the light reveals his subjects at their most meaningful.

"Eloquent Light is the illumination that captures nature's beauty, from the crisp morning air at sunrise, to reflections in water, to light dancing off hills, trails, mountain peaks or canyon walls," says Bogle. "It is the quiet in nature to present as I see it. The images I have chosen for this show express the beauty of the outdoors from the Lowcountry to national and state parks and locations throughout
