The Art League of Hilton Head, SC, will present *Imagination & Fabrication*, featuring works by members of Art Quilters of the Lowcountry, on view in the Art League Gallery, inside Arts Center of Coastal Carolina, from Apr. 9 through May 4, 2019. A reception will be held on Apr. 10, from 5-7pm.

The exhibition celebrates fiber art and its unique ability, using various textures and quilting, to create the illusion of a third dimension. The artist's imagination creates the design and their skilled use of fabric, thread, dyes, embellishments and quilting fabricates the final work of art. To illustrate this concept, the Art Quilters, in addition to their own artwork, took the same photograph and used their imagination to create five different fabricated versions which will also be on exhibit



from many art classes and workshops that change monthly.

Art League Gallery features local artwork in all media created by more than 170 member artists. All artwork on display is for sale and exhibits change every month. Located mid-island inside Arts Center of Coastal Carolina, next to the box office.
