Williams to form New Bern ArtWorks & Company LLC. The gallery was still located at 323B Middle Street until the purchase and renovation of the 1918 (4,500) square-foot, historic former Baxter Jewelry Store. The renovation and move was completed in 2011. The gallery is now located at 323 Pollock Street. New Bern ArtWorks & Company remained the same in many ways but the vision broadened. In 2013, the relocation two years behind them, the partners decided it was time for a new name, "Fine Art at Baxters." The new name will more accurately reflect the line-up of high-quality fine art created by emerging and established local and regional artists exhibited in the stately Baxter building.






