This was the motivation that drove Scott to move to New York City. Homeless and alone, he slept in Central Park for two days. Not giving up on his dream, Scott ended up staying for three years, performing at some of the hottest clubs in New York, such as Stand Up NY, Boston Comedy Club, and the Uptown Comedy Club.

Born and raised in Washington, DC, Scott moved back home and won the 2003 Kings and Queens of Comedy contest. He has appeared on BET's *Comic View and Grins*, a local DC cable TV comedy showcase. He is becoming one of the hottest comedians in our nation's capital and can be seen performing in clubs and colleges from New York to Atlanta.
