Cameron Art Museum in Wilmington, NC, Offers Annual Lantern Exhibition

The Cameron Art Museum in Wilmington, NC, will present *Illumination 2023*, the museum's 9th annual incarnation of this popular artist-made lantern exhibition and competition, on view from Dec. 1, 2023, through Jan. 14, 2024. An opening night celebration will be held on Dec. 1, from 6-9pm.
