Sumter County Gallery of Art in Sumter, SC, Offers 2 New Exhibits

The Sumter County Gallery of Art in Sumter, SC, is presenting two new exhibitions including: 42nd South Carolina Watermedia Society Traveling Exhibition and Sumter Artists' Guild Winners Show, both on view through Feb. 15, 2019

The South Carolina Watermedia Society (SCWS) is the largest statewide visual arts group with a mission to promote South Carolina artists by providing exhibition opportunities, special programs to market their original works and coordinate educational programs. In addition, our goals include public outreach and participation in the arts. Since 1977, the SCWS has been promoting the artistic and professional interests of its members as well as showcasing the accomplishments of its members to a broader South Carolina audience.

The juror for the 2018 SCWS show was West Virginia artist Laurie Goldstein Warren. She observes, "I have been painting watercolors for seventeen years. Art has always been a part of my life. When I was young, dancing was my creative outlet. I was a dancer in the Rochester Academy of Performing Arts dance troupe until the age of 18. When I moved to West Virginia in 1998 and found myself in the countryside, I went back to one of my first creative loves, visual art. After many years of studying the art of watercolor with some fantastic teachers and mentors, I have been so fortunate to be successful in this field. My artwork has been shown all over the United States as well as Canada, China and Japan. I now enjoy teaching workshops and jurying exhibitions around the country.

Honorable Mentions include: Randy Abbott, *Points & Stares*, first time entrant Dominique Hodge, The Beginning, The End and Jim Wade, Chair. J. Michael McGuirt's brave little bird Gathering Courage, spoke to many visitors and won the 2018 Sumter Artists' Guild Show People's Choice Award. The work of all seven of these artists will be on display in the Sumter Artists' Guild Winners exhibition.

Fine Arts Center of Kershaw County in Camden, SC, Features Works by Sam Compton and Catherine Coulter Lloyd


