Up until last month I didn't think that Ryba's crown was ever going to be taken and taken in such a big way, but it did, so all things are possible. But I don't know what kind of cover might do that or what artists living in the Carolinas could pull it off. Susan Lenz is well traveled in the Carolinas, has several popular blogs, and is well known outside the Carolinas. The *Carolina Arts* Facebook page is open to people all over the United States and beyond. Lenz also does a lot of art residencies and exhibitions around the country. And, she is well known in some very big Facebook groups.

So, it is good to remember that being popular and well connected on social media can also influence and reach more people about your art, maybe even boost the numbers for an artist to wear our crown.


Now I hope people don't think that other covers we have had were not that good, for the most part I select those covers under a fairly complicated process, and a few I just wanted to have. We've had some great covers that didn't for some reason attract a lot of views on our Facebook page, for one reason or another - some it was the time of the year and others had to compete for attention during major holidays. If I knew what made a popular cover I'd select them all the time, but I also pick some that I know wouldn't be that popular just for the sake that art isn't meant to be popular all the time. And, don't get me wrong, there have been covers that I didn't like at all, but in an effort to be well rounded, they are selected from time to time. You should know that if it was solely up to me they would be abstract works, one after another. And, by some of the same artists, over and over. But then that would be dull.

It should also be mentioned that Susan Lenz is a supporter of Carolina Arts. Her company is Mouse House, Inc. in Columbia, SC, and is also a framing business that has advertised with us for well over a decade. If our cover selection was influenced by our supporters, she would have been on the cover long before this and probably several times by now, but *Carolina Arts* has never been a "You Pay, You Play" publication. Our supporters are always at the top of our list - any and all lists, but we've had many more covers by artists that represent galleries or art venues who have never spent one dime with us. We don't roll that way. Other publications work that way - we don't. Our covers are not for sale. Our heading on every issue of our publication has stated that since 1987, "Absolutely FREE, You Can't Buy It".


