Spartanburg Art Museum in Spartanburg, SC, Features Works by Bailie and David Linn

The Spartanburg Art Museum, located in the Chapman Cultural Arts Center in Spartanburg, SC, is presenting *Transcendence*, featuring works by Bailie and David Linn, on view through June 28, 2025.

This exhibition examines the mental, spiritual, and physical struggles of humanity captured through the lenses of two distinct and talented artists, Spartanburg local Bailie, and Utah-based David Linn. As Bailie puts it, "*Transcendence* is more than just an exhibit – it's an invitation to embark on a journey of self-discovery and creative exploration."

Bailie, is a locally renowned painter, sculptor, and muralist. His works in *Transcendence* include an eclectic array of pieces in three strikingly different media. Bailie's pieces, drawn from different bodies of work, include vivid abstract paintings, sculptures representing mental illness based on real-life interviews, and his whimsical character creations. Bailie toes the line between the serious and the fantastical. He hopes that his art will inspire visitors to tap into their own creativity and the transformative power of art.

David Linn was born in Palo Alto,
