the viewer want to take a closer look and present a situation where they are entertained by unique and aesthetically intriguing expressions.”

Merett graduated from the University of Georgia and holds two master’s degrees from the University of South Carolina. Because art played such an important role in her school years, she studied art education and taught art in public schools for 30 years and served as adjunct at the University of South Carolina.

Merett’s art has been shown in solo and group exhibits at 701 Whaley’s Hallway: community art gallery, Stormwater Studio, ArtFields, Koger Center for the Arts, the Jasper Project, USC’s McMaster Gallery, SC State Library and Fair, and other local venues like Sound Bites Eatery, Trustus Theater, Cottontown Art Crawl and Melrose Art in the Yard. Her work is published in the Jasper Project’s *Jasper Magazine* Spring 2019 and Fall 2022 editions, in *Sheltered: SC Artists Respond During the 2020 Pandemic*; and in *Bullets and Band-Aids, Vol. 3*.

She published the book *Tall Women* showcasing her “Tall Women” series of work and ekphrastic poems from distinguished female poets from SC and has



authored several articles for the Jasper Project’s *Jasper Magazine*.

Merett has two children, four grandchildren, and lives in Lexington, SC.
