

Arts Center of Kershaw County | The Sumter County Gallery of in Camden, SC, Presents Traveling Jasper Project Exhibit | Guild Exhibition

In its most ambitious project to date, Columbia's Jasper Project will present The Supper Table – enlisting the talents of almost 60 of South Carolina's most outstanding women artists from the fields of visual, literary, theatrical arts, and film, on view in the Bassett Gallery at the Arts Center of Kershaw County in Camden, SC, through Sept. 3, 2021.

A homage to Judy Chicago's iconic feminist art installation, The Dinner Party, and using Chicago's project as a loose model, Jasper Project executive director Cindi Boiter conceived of The Supper *Table* as an innovative way of honoring some of SC's largely uncelebrated, yet ground-breaking women in history. Boiter elected 12 historical SC women who, via their work in the arts, medicine, law, business, athletics, entertainment, and more, changed the course of human history.

Using the model created by Chicago, Boiter commissioned Jordan Morris to create a 12' x 12' x 12' wooden table at which visual artists would create placesettings inspired by and honoring the historical women. In addition to the 12 visual artists, a dozen artists each from the literary and theatrical arts as well as film were also invited to participate. The result is a multidisciplinary arts installation, a series of 12 looped 90-second films, essays written by 12 literary artists, and, of course, the installation of the table itself, complete with 12 place-settings.

Funded in part by a Connected Communities grant from Central Carolina Community Foundation, The Supper Table includes a collection of 12 original portraits of the honored women created by Artfields People's Choice winner Kirkland
